The organization has approximately 500 employees with an operating budget of more than \$200 million. USAC works in close partnership with the FCC and other federal and state partners to support the achievement of the USF program goals. USAC administers the USF programs-High Cost, Lifeline, Rural Health Care, and Schools and Libraries. USAC strives to provide efficient, responsible stewardship of the programs, a key national asset in making important telecommunications and Internet services available to consumers, health care providers, schools, and libraries throughout the United States. The program divisions are supported by additional USAC personnel in Finance, General Counsel, Information Systems, Internal the Enterprise Program Management Office and Human Resources. 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
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
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
